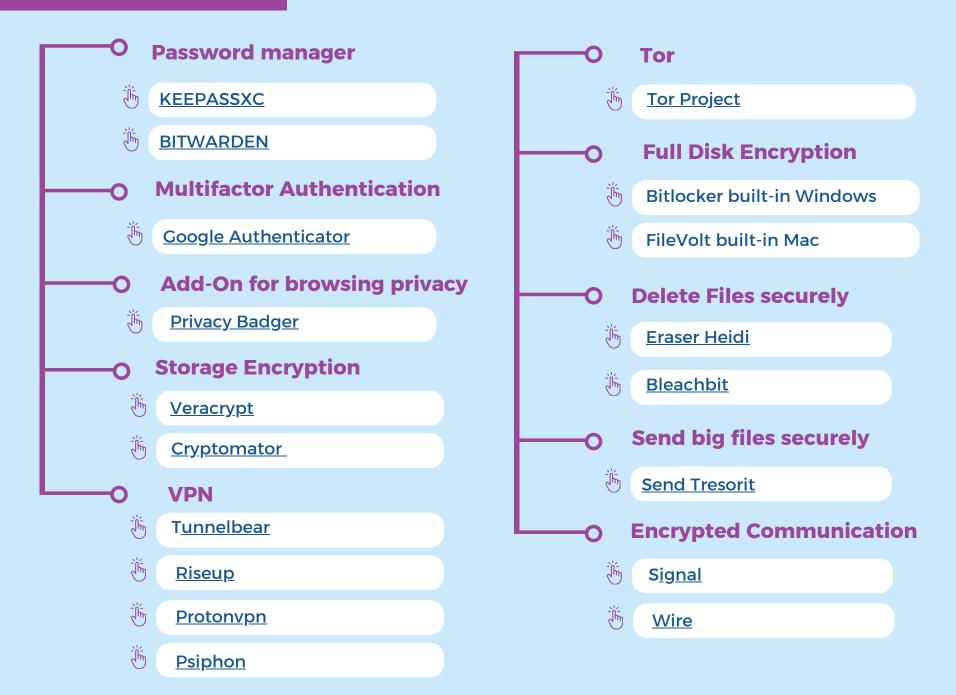

Behavior Change
